Our work brings tangible value to mentoring programs and provides needed resources and professional development – two vital components for sustainable programs.

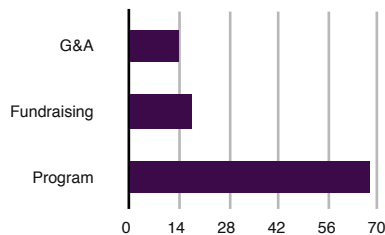

Major initiatives or activities include:

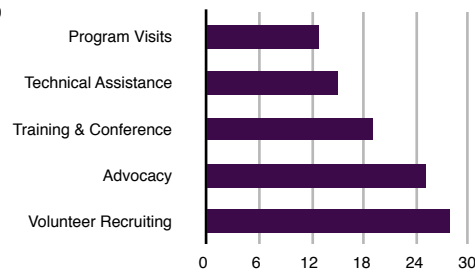
- ✓ Opening a Southern Oregon office in Medford that serves the regional mentoring programs
- ✓ Realigning our identity to clarify the work we do; including a new logo and messaging
- ✓ Planning and implementation of our Web site revision working to: streamline content and update resources; improve the functionality of the volunteer referral system; and increase our statewide reach
- ✓ Planning the regional Youth Development Networks project -- an initiative to place coordinators throughout the state who will convene local youth serving organizations, establish common goals and work together to achieve those goals.
- ✓ Completed our first round of visits to 76 programs around the state. Staff gained valuable information, built stronger relationships and have a more attuned understanding of program needs in various regions.



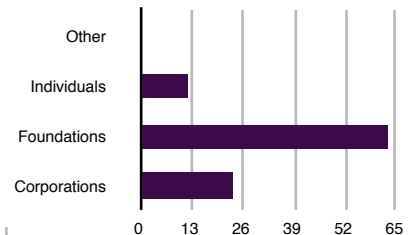
Mentor Portland
