

Oregon Mentors Registered Program Benefits



Oregon Mentors is the statewide expert and advocate for youth mentoring programs offering a wide variety of services and support to program staff.

Programs registered with Oregon Mentors receive a number of benefits, listed below. Program registration is free and only requires a one-time application and completion of an annual data survey for each year a program is registered. Youth mentoring programs operating in Oregon or SW Washington that have 501(c)(3) status or are part of a government body and complete background checks on their mentors are eligible to register.

- Reduced fee for Oregon Mentors facilitation for your planning sessions and meetings
- Reduced fee for new program staff all-day workshop
- Reduced fee for Oregon Mentors scheduled trainings
- Reduced tuition to Oregon Mentors Bi-Annual Conference
- Free day of set up and technical assistance with MentorPRO (match support software)
- \$100 scholarship toward trainings and workshops from the Nonprofit Association of Oregon
- Network meetings for Portland-Area programs
- Legislative updates when mentoring and/or youth development initiatives are occurring
- Free Webinars on topics related to mentoring and nonprofit leadership
